The Jefferson Institute, in cooperation with the University of Missouri, invites you to learn about sunflowers and other alternative crops, including new sunflower herbicide and variety options.

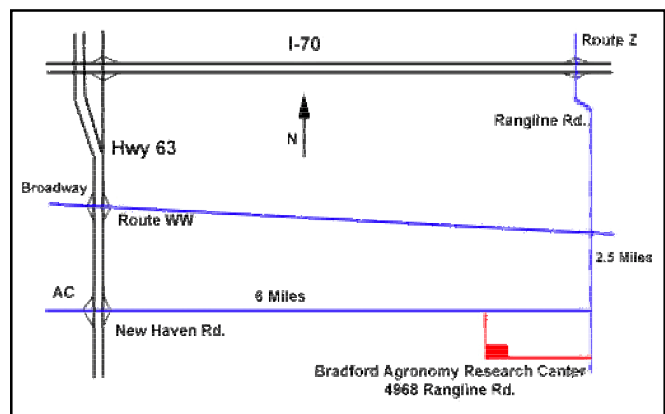
Herbicide Trials — Producers who attend this year will benefit from the illustration and discussion of improved sunflower herbicide options.

Sunflower Variety Trial — Ten sunflower varieties from companies including Cargill, Triumph, Croplan Genetics, Pioneer and Mycogen.

Information Resources — Staff from Jefferson Institute and MU, herbicide and seed representatives, and current producers will be present to answer questions about sunflower production and marketing.

Alternative Crops — Variety testing of 9 amaranth varieties and 6 black bean varieties, as well as plots of buckwheat, millets, flax, and kenaf can also be viewed.
